

Balance sheet bingo

Instructions to teachers or trainers

1. Give a bingo card to each learner (or each buzz group).
2. Ask the learners to match the definition you call out to the correct word. For example, you call out, "All the assets minus all the liabilities". They cover up 'Net assets' with a counter (or similar).
3. Instruct learners they can call bingo for a line down, a line across or the four corners, then continue to play for a full house.
4. Put the definition cards in a bag (or similar) and shake up.
5. Pick out a card and read the definition out only.
6. Put the definition card on the master sheet (so that you can check the answers at the end).
7. If a learner or buzz group calls 'bingo' you can check their answers against the master sheet.

Declare the winner and then continue with the activity until all the definitions have been read out.
